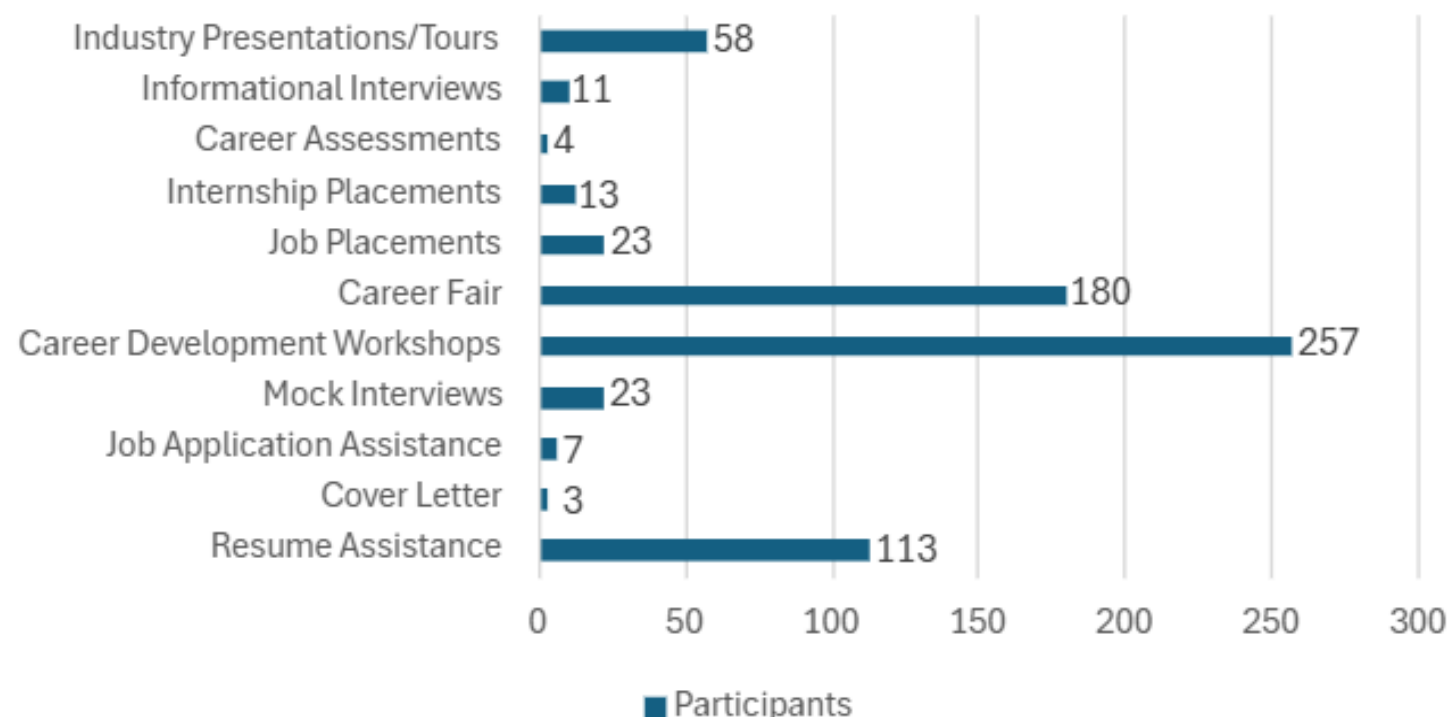

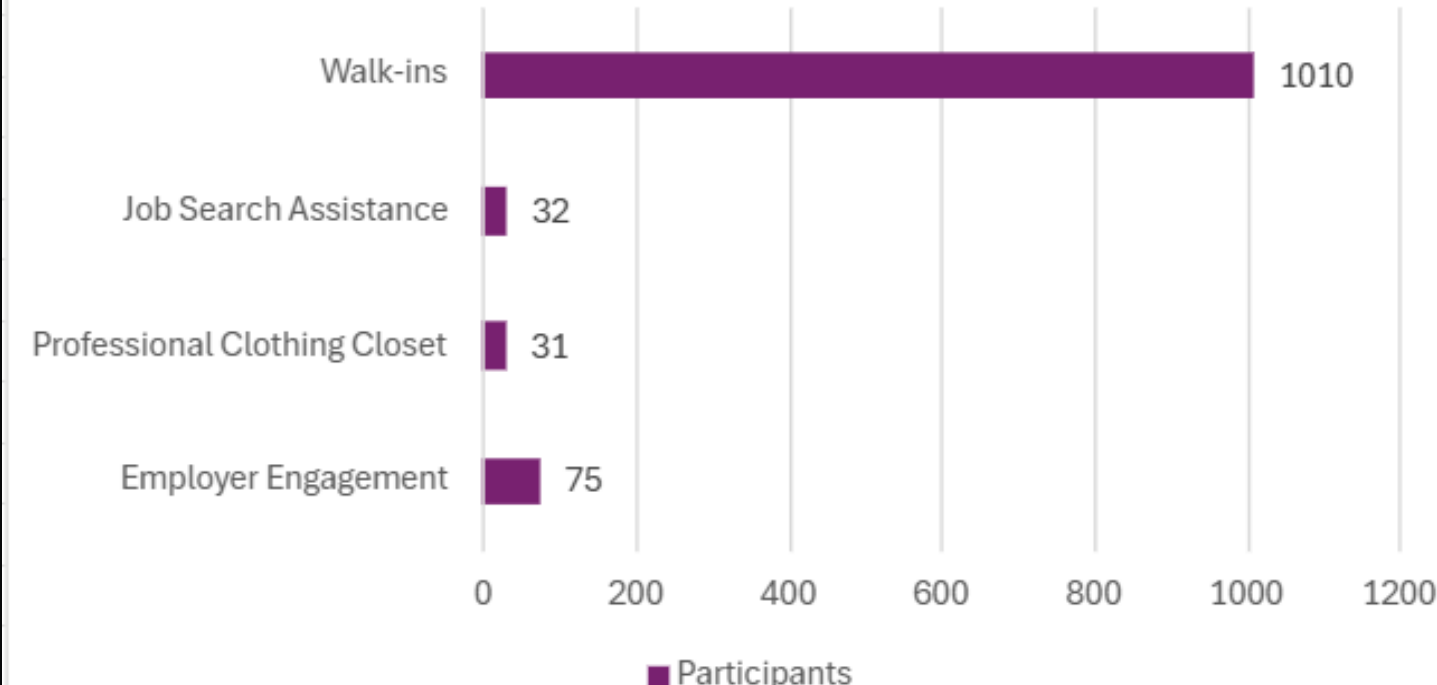

# Student Equity & Services Promise Program



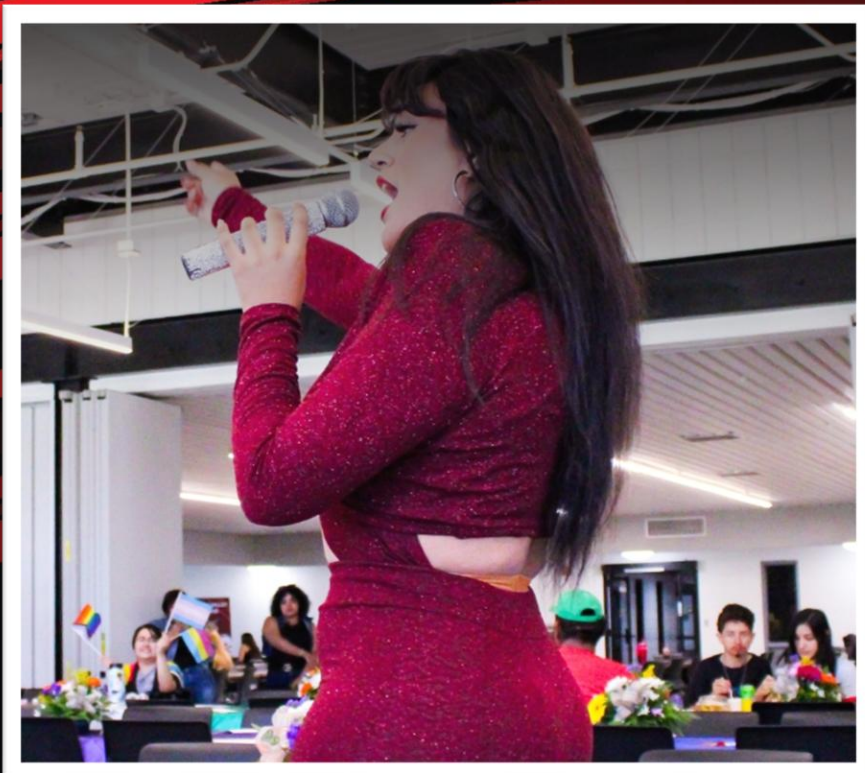

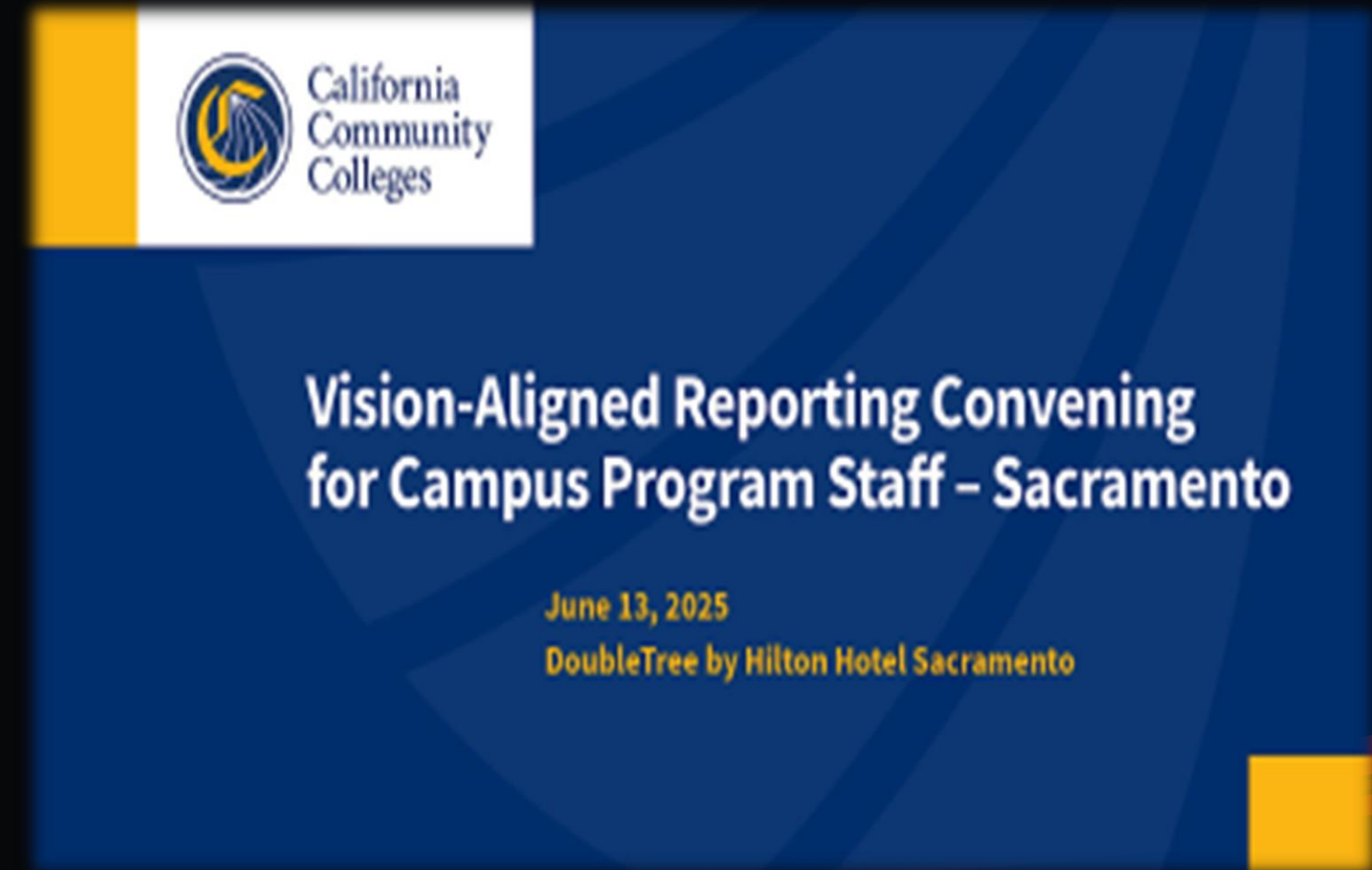
