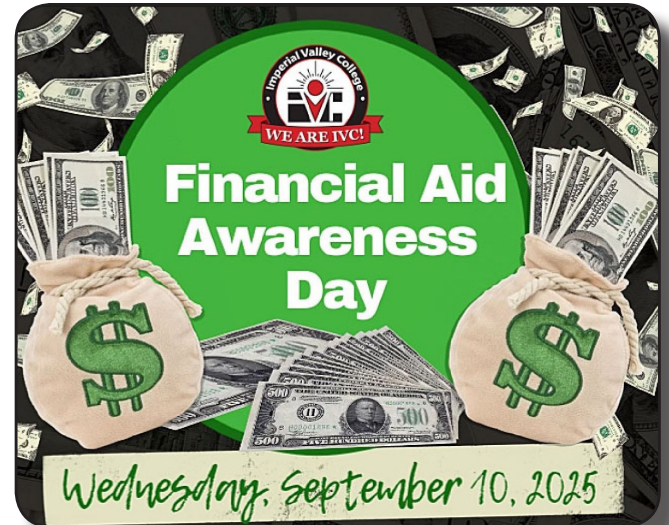
- \$50.3 million has been disbursed

- Local banks and various Campus Programs will share valuable information with students regarding finances

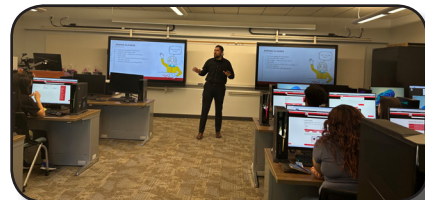


TRiO ETS and SSS hosted **Bridge Workshops in July and August:** Supported 50+ incoming IVC students.

Student Housing Program

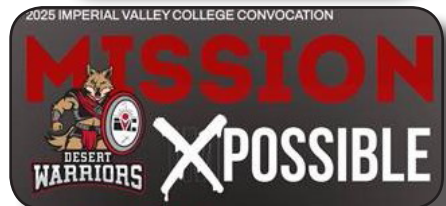


- Student Housing launched **bi-monthly workshops** to boost resident engagement; Aug. 14 workshop saw 55% participation, with a second session set for Aug. 20.

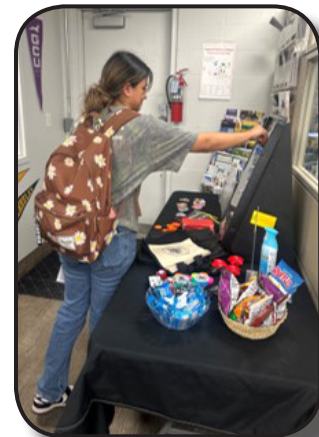
- **Monday, August 11, 2025:** 113 students advised.
