



SEA Program Matriculation Core Services

- Counselors & Specialists assisted 2,462 students in completing IVC admission applications for the Fall 24.
- Counselors completed 2,039 Abbreviated Student Education Plans at all the local high schools during the spring semester.
- July 9, 2024, over 800 students participated and registered for classes for Fall 2024 in the SEA Program Registration event within 3 hours.



Financial Aid

- 2024-25 FAFSA Processing.
- 7,000 Unduplicated FAFSAs received.
- Despite delays and complications due to new FAFSA regulations, we are gaining ground daily.
- Mid-June, we were 20% below this time last year.
- As of July 11th, we are only 6% below this time last year.






