III. Approval Of Minutes

IV. New Electrical Certificate Fall 21'

Mr. Roman showed the committee his presentation that he presented to the Counselors. He explained the Electrical Program and showed the list of schools that are ET card approved.

1. General Electrician Certificate

The certificate was shown to the committee listing all of the courses that will be offered during Fall 21'. General Electrician consists of Commercial and Industrial electricians and is about 8,000 on the job training hours. EWIR 160 Programmer

Logic Controller was added to the certificate and will be offered in the Spring of 2022.

2. Residential Electrician Certificate

The certificate was shown to the committee listing all the courses that will be offered during Fall 21'. This Certificate is about 4,800 on the job training hours.

3. Low Voltage Systems Technology-Spring 2020

Mr. Roman informed the faculty that the Low Voltage Systems started in Spring 2020.

4. Journeyman Electrician Training Update

V. Advisory Committee Handbook

Janeth Cruz showed the committee the newly updated Advisory Handbook and explained the purpose of the Advisory Committee.

VI. Perkins Update & Strong Workforce Updates

Approved for \$28,000 for Perkins funding and \$26,000 for Strong Workforce.

VIII. Fall 21' Update

The students will be on campus for the full 16 weeks and when courses have lecture and lab on different days they will have lecture on zoom and lab on campus. Safety protocols will still be put in place.

IX. Career Services Center

A. Placement Services

Genaro Ayla informed the committee about two programs for employers. The OJT program allows for employers to get reimbursed 90% of wages paid and is for 12 weeks depending on the amount of experience the student has. Pre-screening will be done for employers. Have to be in business for 120 days and have not recently laid off an employee, employees will need the necessary breaks by law. WEX Program the employer will not be the employer on record, the county pays the wages and will be the employer on record. This program is for those students that have very limited experience in the field. Proof of residency and income based.

B. Internships

Janeth Cruz explained that the work experience internship course involves internship hours which comes out to 60 hours and is asking for help from industries to hire student interns so they can complete their hours.

X. New Faculty Hiring Guidelines

Mr. Silva informed the committee that the faculty hiring guidelines has changed to allow the hiring of a faculty member without the degree if they have the experience. Academic Senate approved equivalency form to be used in place of those applicants that don't have the degree.
