Spring 2010 Instructions for Reading Lab assignments:

- Number of assignments (6).
- Due dates and deadlines:
 - o Each assignment has a start date and due date. Assignments are two weeks long, starting on Saturday at 9:00 A.M. and ending every other Friday at 3:00 P.M.
- Assignments cannot be started before the beginning date or completed after the deadline.
- Checking into and out of the lab does not guarantee that an assignment is complete.
- No partial credit is given: the whole assignment needs to be completed in order to receive credit.
- Two types of assignments:
 - My Reading Lab:
 - Completion is based on:
 - o achieving Mastery on skills tests: 70% comprehension on both Practice exercises and Tests
 - o doing a Reading Level selection: both Diagnostic and Exercise
 - The student may take as much time as necessary to score 70% comprehension for each two-week assignment.
 - o Do not go to the Test until you have scored the appropriate percentage on the Practice.
 - o If a student uses up all of the Practices and/or Tests without scoring the appropriate percentage, we can reset them.
 - o Scores for the Reading Level selection cannot be reset.
 - Do not do the Reading Level selection until after you have done the Reading Skills section.
 - The program indicates time on task for the Reading Level selection, which should be recorded on the information sheet.
 - If you let the program run for 5 minutes without doing anything, you will be logged off and will have to log back on to continue your work.
 - Due dates and comprehension requirements apply to both in-Lab and at-home work.
 - o The program works best with a high-speed internet connection, but can be done with dial up.

o Phonics:

- Phonics constitutes one assignment but has two parts. The phonics *diagnostic* is given first; then the phonics *exercises* and *tests* are assigned and must be completed during the same assignment block.
- Phonics exercises are based on the diagnostic test, so the diagnostic test <u>must</u> be done in order to receive credit for Phonics.
- Every assigned Phonics exercise must be completed correctly and signed by a tutor in order to receive credit.
